**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

**AN ACT**

Relative to Certain Conditions under which a Person, Firm or Corporation may employ Strike-breakers during the Strike Period.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. No person, firm or corporation during  
2 the continuance of a strike, lockout or other labor trouble  
3 among the employees of another person, firm or corpora-  
4 tion shall procure or attempt to procure persons to work  
5 for such person, firm or corporation without informing  
6 them that a strike, lockout or other labor trouble exists.

1 SECTION 2. If any person, firm, association or corpo-  
2 ration violates any provision of this act, he or it shall  
3 be punished by a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars  
4 for each offence.

1 SECTION 3. The provisions of this act and of chapter  
2 four hundred and forty-five of the acts of the year nine-  
3 teen hundred and ten shall apply to advertisements or  
4 other attempts whether in this commonwealth or else-  
5 where.
