Resolve accompanying the petition of Harry L. Tower and another relative to the improvement of Nippinicket Pond in the town of Bridgewater. Public Health. January 22.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

RESOLVE

To provide for an Investigation of Nippinicket Pond in the
Town of Bridgewater.

1 *Resolved*, That the state board of health is hereby
2 authorized and directed to examine Nippinicket pond
3 in the town of Bridgewater and the bed and shores
4 thereof, and the stream flowing therefrom, to ascertain
5 if the condition of the pond is becoming objectionable
6 or injurious to health by reason of any excessive or un-
7 usual growth of vegetation in the bed, shores, or waters of
8 the pond or of the stream into which it flows. The
9 board is also authorized and directed to make such
10 other examinations of said pond as may be necessary to
11 determine whether there are material fluctuations in
12 the level of the water, and whether any regulation of
13 the height of water in said pond is desirable. The board
14 shall report the results of its investigations, with such
15 recommendations as it may deem expedient, to the next
16 general court on or before January fifteenth.
