Bill accompanying the petition of Benjamin F. Haines relative to the selling of eggs falsely marked. Public Health. January 22.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Sale of Eggs falsely marked.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section twelve of chapter seventy-two of the Re-
2 vised Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
3 the word " whoever ", in the first line, the words:
4 — with intent to defraud, — so as to read as fol-
5 lows: — *Section 12.* Whoever, with intent to de-
6 fraud, knowingly sells or exposes for sale goods
7 upon which any lawful name or label or any coun-
8 terfeit or imitation thereof is unlawfully affixed,
9 impressed or used shall be punished by a fine of not
10 more than two hundred dollars or by imprisonment
11 for not more than one year, or by both such fine and
12 imprisonment.
