## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

### AN ACT

To authorize the City of Boston to appoint Eugene M. Byington a Member of the Fire Department without Civil Service Examination.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The city of Boston is hereby authorized to appoint  
2 Eugene M. Byington, connected with the fire depart-  
3 ment of said city of Boston since eighteen hundred  
4 and ninety and now superintendent of the repair  
5 shop and supervisor of engines in the fire depart-  
6 ment of said city, to be made a member of the fire  
7 department, with all the rights, privileges and emol-  
8 uments of the fire-fighting force of said department  
9 without reference to the requirements of the civil  
10 service.
