## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

### AN ACT

Relative to the Issue of Licenses to Certain Children of Civil War Veterans.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Any person who is the son of a civil war  
2 veteran, and who was under fifteen years of age at the  
3 time of his father's enlistment, shall be entitled to receive,  
4 without fee, from the secretary of the commonwealth,  
5 a pedlar's license to sell goods or wares in any part of  
6 the commonwealth.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
