## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

### AN ACT

Relative to the Printing and Distribution of the Annual Report of the State Board of Agriculture.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section seven of chapter nine of the  
2 Revised Laws is hereby amended by striking out  
3 lines thirty-four to forty, inclusive, and inserting  
4 in place thereof the following: — Of the state board  
5 of agriculture, not more than ten thousand copies.  
6 Such parts of said report as the secretary of said  
7 board may deem best adapted to promote the in-  
8 terests of agriculture may be published separately,  
9 for general distribution; the expense of such publi-  
10 cation to be met out of the appropriation for print-  
11 ing said report.

1 SECTION 2. Section eight of said chapter nine,  
2 as amended by chapter four hundred and twenty-

3 two of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and  
4 eight, is hereby further amended by striking out  
5 lines eleven to thirteen, inclusive, and inserting in  
6 place thereof the following:— Each member of the  
7 general court, and the clerk of each branch thereof,  
8 shall also be entitled to receive, upon application,  
9 not more than twenty-five copies each of such parts  
10 of the annual report of the state board of agricul-  
11 ture as may be published separately in accordance  
12 with the preceding section, so that the last para-  
13 graph of said section eight will read as follows:—  
14 Each member of the general court, and the clerk  
15 of each branch thereof, shall also be entitled to re-  
16 ceive, upon application, not more than twenty-five  
17 copies each of such parts of the annual report  
18 of the state board of agriculture as may be pub-  
19 lished separately in accordance with the preceding  
20 section, seven additional copies of the report of the  
21 board of health, and of the report of the bureau  
22 of statistics of labor; five additional copies of the  
23 report of the secretary of the board of education,  
24 and of the report of statistics of manufactures.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
