

Bill accompanying the petition of Lewis R. Sullivan relative to the pension of Edwin J. Egan, a former employee of the fire department of the city of Boston. Cities. January 27.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of Boston to pension Edwin J. Egan.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston is hereby author-
2 ized to pay an annual pension of six hundred and
3 fifty dollars to or for the benefit of Edwin J. Egan,
4 a former member of the fire department of the city,
5 who became insane from an injury received during
6 the course of his employment. The said pension
7 shall be paid to a guardian appointed for the pur-
8 pose, or in such other manner as shall be deter-
9 mined by the fire commissioner of the city, and after
10 his death shall be paid to his widow, if she survives
11 him; and if she does not survive him, then to and
12 for the benefit of his surviving children, so long as
13 they are minors.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
