RESOLUTIONS

In support of an Amendment of the Naturalization Laws of the United States.

1 *Resolved*, That the general court of Massachusetts,
2 believing that there is injustice both to the alien desiring
3 to become a citizen and to the state because of the lack
4 of interest in the government of unnaturalized aliens
5 growing out of the present difficulty in securing naturali-
6 zation papers, respectfully petitions the congress of the
7 United States that congress shall amend the law relating
8 to naturalization so as to make it less expensive to the
9 alien to become a citizen.

10 *Resolved*, That certified copies of these resolutions be
11 sent by the secretary of the commonwealth to the presi-
12 dent of the United States, to the presiding officers of both
13 branches of congress, and to each of the senators and
14 representatives from Massachusetts.
