

HOUSE No. 2004

Bill accompanying the petition of the mayor of the city of Woburn relative to extending the civil service laws so as to apply to the city treasurer of said city. Public Service. January 27.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

To provide for the Appointment or Election of the City Treasurer of the City of Woburn under the Civil Service Laws.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The appointment or election of a city
2 treasurer in the city of Woburn shall be for an indetermi-
3 nate period, and shall be subject to the civil service
4 rules established under the provisions of chapter nine-
5 teen of the Revised Laws and acts in amendment thereof
6 and in addition thereto.

1 SECTION 2. The city treasurer of the city of Woburn
2 holding office at the time of the acceptance of this act
3 shall continue to hold office as if appointed or elected
4 under this act.

1 SECTION 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 herewith are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall be submitted to the voters
2 of the city of Woburn at the next annual state election,
3 and shall take effect upon its acceptance by a majority
4 of the voters voting thereon; otherwise it shall not take
5 effect.
