

Bill accompanying the petition of James T. Bagshaw relative to the hours of labor of minors. Social Welfare. January 27.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Labor of Minors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section eight of chapter eight hundred and thirty-
2 one of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and
3 thirteen is hereby amended by striking out the word
4 “ forty-eight ”, in the fifth line, and inserting in
5 place thereof the word:—fifty-four, — and by strik-
6 ing out the word “ eight ”, in the same line, and in-
7 serting in place thereof the word:— ten, — so as to
8 read as follows:— *Section 8.* No minor under six-
9 teen years of age shall be employed or permitted to
10 work in, about or in connection with any establish-
11 ment or occupation named in section one for more
12 than six days in any one week, nor more than fifty-
13 four hours in any one week, nor more than ten hours
14 in any one day, nor before the hour of half-past six
15 o'clock in the morning, nor after the hour of six
16 o'clock in the evening of any day.
