## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

### AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Maintenance of the  
Rutland State Sanatorium.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are  
2 appropriated for the maintenance of the Rutland  
3 state sanatorium for the fiscal year ending on the  
4 thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and  
5 fourteen, to wit:—

6 From the receipts of said sanatorium now in the  
7 treasury of the commonwealth, the sum of forty-one  
8 thousand six hundred sixty-seven dollars and three  
9 cents; and from the treasury of the commonwealth  
10 from the ordinary revenue, a sum not exceeding one  
11 hundred fifty-one thousand four hundred and  
12 thirty-two dollars and ninety-seven cents. (Acts  
13 1905, ch. 175; 1909, ch. 504.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
