AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for operating the North Metropolitan System of Sewage Disposal.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding one hundred and
2 seventy-three thousand dollars is hereby appro-
3 priated, to be paid out of the North Metropolitan
4 System Maintenance Fund, for the maintenance and
5 operation of a system of sewage disposal for the
6 cities included in what is known as the north metro-
7 politan system, during the fiscal year ending on the
8 thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and
9 fourteen. (Acts 1889, ch. 439, sect. 13.)

(Appropriation 1913, \$170,600.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
