AN ACT

To authorize the County of Plymouth to Pension Frank H. Cushman.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The county of Plymouth may pay an-
2 nually to Frank H. Cushman of Plymouth a sum not to
3 exceed one half of the annual compensation which he re-
4 ceived as an officer of the house of correction of Plymouth
5 county at the time of his retirement from service, said
6 payment by the county to date from May first in the year
7 nineteen hundred and twelve, with the approval of the
8 county commissioners. The said Cushman, for more than
9 twenty-five years, faithfully served the commonwealth as
10 a prison officer, and was compelled to resign on account of
11 physical disability.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
