AN ACT

To regulate the Sale of Second-hand Articles of Clothing
in the City of Cambridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. No person, firm or corporation shall en-
2 gage in or continue the business, in whole or in part,
3 of dealing in second-hand articles of clothing or other
4 wearing apparel, mattresses or bedding in the city of
5 Cambridge without a permit from the board of health of
6 the city. The permits shall be issued for such time and
7 under such conditions as the board of health shall deter-
8 mine.

1 SECTION 2. Whoever violates the provisions of this
2 act shall be punished by a fine not exceeding one hun-
3 dred dollars.
