### RESOLVE

In favor of Walter B. Robinson of Natick.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 treasury of the commonwealth to Walter B. Robinson  
3 of Natick the sum of one hundred dollars to reimburse  
4 him for damages to his property in that part of Walpole  
5 called South Walpole by fire occasioned by sparks from  
6 a steam roller owned by the commonwealth and operated  
7 under the direction of the Massachusetts highway com-  
8 mission, on or about the twentieth day of May, nineteen  
9 hundred and thirteen.
