Bill accompanying the petition of George H. Ellis for legislation to authorize the Franklin Typographical Society to hold additional real and personal estate. Mercantile Affairs. April 9.

AN ACT

To authorize the Franklin Typographical Society to hold
Additional Real and Personal Estate.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The Franklin Typographical Society, a
2 corporation chartered in the year eighteen hundred and
3 twenty-five, is hereby authorized to hold additional real
4 estate for the purposes of said society, provided that the
5 whole amount so held shall not exceed one hundred thou-
6 sand dollars in value, and to hold additional personal
7 estate for the purposes of said society, provided that the
8 whole amount so held shall not exceed seventy-five thou-
9 sand dollars in value.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
