AN ACT

Relative to the Salaries of the Judge and Register of Probate
and Insolvency for the County of Nantucket.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The annual salaries of the judge and
2 register of probate and insolvency for the county of
3 Nantucket shall be respectively thirteen hundred and
4 ten hundred dollars, both to date from the first day of
5 January of the current year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
