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### RESOLVE

To provide for Buildings and Improvements at the Lakeville  
State Sanatorium.

1   *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding thirty-seven hun-  
2   dred dollars be paid out of the treasury of the common-  
3   wealth, from the ordinary revenue, to be expended under  
4   the direction of the trustees of hospitals for consump-  
5   tives at the Lakeville state sanatorium for the following  
6   purposes:— For installing a bakery and equipment, an  
7   addition to the refrigerator for milk and butter and a  
8   porch for nurses, a sum not exceeding three thousand five  
9   hundred dollars; and for installing screens for new build-  
10  ings, a sum not exceeding two hundred dollars.
