RESOLVE

To provide for Certain Improvements at the Medfield State Hospital.

1 *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding twenty-seven thou-
2 sand dollars, to be paid out of the treasury of the com-
3 monwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for constructing
4 and furnishing a dispensary building at the Medfield
5 state hospital, to be expended under the direction of the
6 trustees of said hospital.
