## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

### RESOLVE

To provide for protecting the Easterly Bank of the Connecticut River in the Town of South Hadley.

1 *Resolved*, That the board of harbor and land com-  
2 missioners is hereby authorized and directed to examine  
3 that part of the easterly bank of the Connecticut river  
4 in the town of South Hadley between the factory of the  
5 Hadley mills and the county bridge between South Had-  
6 ley Falls in South Hadley and Holyoke, and, if in its  
7 opinion it is necessary and desirable, may build such  
8 protective works as may be necessary to protect the bank  
9 and property near the outlet of Buttery brook, and for  
10 this purpose may expend a sum not exceeding four thou-  
11 sand dollars: *provided*, that the town of South Hadley  
12 appropriates the sum of one thousand dollars for the said  
13 purpose.
