

HOUSE No. 2672

Bill accompanying the petition of Robert C. Sherman and others that the city of New Bedford be authorized to lay out a public highway through certain property used for cemetery purposes.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of New Bedford to extend Liberty Street through Oak Grove Cemetery.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of New Bedford is hereby au-
2 thorized to lay out and construct under the provisions of
3 the Revised Laws as a public highway an extension of
4 Liberty street, so called, through Oak Grove cemetery in
5 said city: *provided* said extension shall not exceed fifty
6 feet in width within said cemetery property; and *pro-*
7 *vided further*, that said extension shall not be laid out
8 or constructed through any portion of said cemetery
9 which is or has been used for burial purposes.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
