RESOLVE

To provide for Certain Improvements at the Gardner State Colony.

1. *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the commonwealth, from the ordinary rev-
3 enue, a sum not exceeding fifteen hundred dollars, to be
4 expended at the Gardner state colony, under the direction
5 of the trustees thereof, for the following purposes:—
6 For constructing a slaughter house, a sum not exceeding
7 eight hundred dollars, and for an extension to the barn
8 at Belcher cottage, a sum not exceeding seven hundred
9 dollars.
