RESOLVE

To provide for Additional Buildings at the Worcester State Hospital.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the commonwealth for improvements at the
3 Worcester state hospital the sum of one hundred and
4 twelve thousand eight hundred dollars, to be expended
5 under the direction of the trustees thereof, for the fol-
6 lowing purposes:— For constructing a two story and
7 basement building for laundry and industrial purposes,
8 for removing thereto the machinery of the present laun-
9 dry and for converting the present laundry building into
10 a dining room, a sum not exceeding one hundred thou-
11 sand eight hundred dollars; for constructing and fur-
12 nishing two cottages for employees, a sum not exceeding
13 twelve thousand dollars.
