AN ACT

Making an Appropriation to meet Additional Expenses in the Litigation between the Commonwealth and the Haverhill Gas Light Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The sum of eleven thousand five hundred dollars is
2 hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of
3 the commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, for the
4 purpose of meeting additional expenses in the litigation
5 between the commonwealth of Massachusetts and the
6 Haverhill Gas Light Company, which expenses have
7 not been heretofore provided for, the same to be in addi-
8 tion to any amount heretofore appropriated.
