AN ACT

Relative to the Amount of Money authorized to be borrowed by the City of Lawrence for the Construction of a Bridge over the Merrimac River.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of constructing a bridge
2 over the Merrimac river in the city of Lawrence, in ac-
3 cordance with the provisions of chapter four hundred
4 and eighty-six of the acts of the year nineteen hundred
5 and seven and chapter five hundred and seventy-two of
6 the acts of the year nineteen hundred and seven, the
7 said city is hereby authorized to borrow the sum of eight
8 hundred thousand dollars, in accordance with the pro-
9 visions of section four of chapter four hundred and
10 eighty-six of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and
11 seven, instead of five hundred thousand dollars, as here-
12 tofore authorized by said acts.

1 SECTION 2. All moneys received from the county of
2 Essex in accordance with the provisions of section two
3 of chapter four hundred and eighty-six of the acts of

4 the year nineteen hundred and seven and any sums re-
5 ceived from a street railway on account of a grant au-
6 thorizing a street railway company to locate upon said
7 bridge for the construction and maintenance of its track
8 or tracks, and of poles and wires for the operation of its
9 railway thereon as provided by section three of chapter
10 four hundred and eighty-six of the acts of the year nine-
11 teen hundred and seven shall be used only for the liquida-
12 tion of indebtedness incurred for the construction of said
13 bridge.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
