Bill accompanying the petition of the mayor of the city of Boston relative to the height of buildings in said city. Cities. June 30.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

Exempting a Certain Parcel of Land in the City of Boston from Restrictions as to the Height of Buildings.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The parcel of land situated in the city of
2 Boston bounded by Washington street, Lovering place,
3 Harrison avenue and Asylum street is hereby exempted
4 from the provisions of chapter three hundred and thirty-
5 three of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and four
6 and chapter three hundred and eighty-three of the acts
7 of the year nineteen hundred and five relating to the
8 height of buildings, and is relieved from the restrictions
9 as to height placed thereon by the commissioners on the
10 height of buildings in the city of Boston acting under
11 the authority of said statutes: *provided, however, that*
12 *nothing herein shall authorize the erection on said parcel*

13 of a building exceeding one hundred and twenty-five feet
14 in height above the grade of the sidewalk on Washington
15 street in front of said parcel, nor the erection of any
16 building thereon except upon a permit duly granted there-
17 for by the building commissioner of the city of Boston.

— 1 — SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
