RESOLVE

To provide for an Investigation by the Commission on Economy and Efficiency relative to the Readjustment of the Finances of the Commonwealth.

1 *Resolved*, That the subject matter of the message from
2 his excellency the governor to the general court relative
3 to the readjustment of the finances of the commonwealth
4 by the retirement of the sinking fund bonds and the issu-
5 ance of serial bonds be referred to the commission on
6 economy and efficiency for their examination and report
7 on the same to the next general court not later than
8 January fifteenth.
