### AN ACT

To provide Vacations for Laborers and Mechanics in the employ of the Metropolitan Park Commission and the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Board.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. All laborers and mechanics regu-  
2 larly employed in the service of the metropolitan  
3 park commission or of the metropolitan water  
4 and sewerage board shall be granted an annual  
5 vacation of not less than two weeks without loss  
6 of pay.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted to the  
2 voters at the state election in the current year for

3 its acceptance or rejection in the cities and towns  
 4 comprising the metropolitan park district, and  
 5 the metropolitan water and sewerage districts,  
 6 north and south, and shall take effect in and for  
 7 each district when accepted by a majority of the  
 8 voters voting thereon in said district in the  
 9 affirmative.
