## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

### AN ACT

To provide for the Resubmission of an Act relative to the Pensioning of Laborers employed by Cities and Towns.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section two of chapter two hundred and seven-  
2 teen of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and  
3 fourteen is hereby amended by adding at the end  
4 thereof the following: — In case of rejection by  
5 the voters of any city or town at said election,  
6 this act shall be resubmitted to said voters at any  
7 subsequent state election upon a petition signed  
8 by the qualified voters of said city or town to-  
9 gether with their names and addresses to a num-

10 ber equal at least to five per cent of the registered  
11 voters at the next preceding municipal election  
12 and certified as such by the city or town clerk.  
13 Said petition shall be filed with the city or town  
14 clerk at least thirty days prior to said state election,  
15 who shall, if the petition complies with the fore-  
16 going provisions therewith, transmit the same to  
17 the secretary of the commonwealth, and the  
18 secretary of the commonwealth shall place said  
19 question upon the ballot to be used in said city  
20 or town at the next state election.
