To accompany the petition of Ralph W. Redding for legislation relative to the powers of the Fire Prevention Commissioner. Metropolitan Affairs.

AN ACT

Relative to the Powers of the Fire Prevention Commissioner.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter seven hundred and
2 ninety-five of the acts of the year nineteen hundred
3 and fourteen is hereby amended by striking out
4 sections ten, eleven and twelve and paragraph M
5 of section thirteen.

1 SECTION 2. Section twenty-two of said chap-
2 ter seven hundred and ninety-five is hereby
3 amended by striking out the word "five", in the
4 last sentence of said section and substituting
5 therefor the word: — one, — so that said sentence

6 as amended will read as follows: — No rule or
7 order shall be made or enforced which requires an
8 expenditure by the owner or occupant of more
9 than one per cent of the last annual assessed
10 value of the land and building to which such rule
11 or order relates.
