

To accompany the petition of Lester S. Lewis and others that a troop of cavalry be established in the city of Springfield. Military Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen.

AN ACT

To establish a Troop of Cavalry in the City of Springfield.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. There shall be established in the
2 city of Springfield in addition to, and as a part of,
3 the active volunteer militia as organized under
4 existing law, a troop of cavalry.

1 SECTION 2. All the provisions of existing law
2 so far as applicable shall apply to the organization,
3 equipment, maintenance and government of said
4 troop of cavalry.

1 SECTION 3. There shall be appropriated out
2 of the treasury of the commonwealth the sum of
3 to defray the expenses of organizing
4 and equipping said troop of cavalry.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
