

SENATE No. 171

To accompany the petition of E. H. Newell that pensions be provided for janitors of school houses and public buildings. Social Welfare.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen.

AN ACT

To provide Pensions for Janitors of Schools and
Public Buildings.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Every janitor or custodian in care of school or
2 public buildings in any city or town in the com-
3 monwealth of Massachusetts, at the age of sixty
4 years, and who has been employed twenty years
5 by said city or town, may retire and shall be paid a
6 pension of one half of his salary that he received
7 one year before the passage of this bill, and at the
8 age of seventy years must retire on half pay.
