

SENATE No. 339

To accompany the petition of Edward F. McLaughlin that the city of Boston be authorized to pay an annuity to the widow of Thomas F. Boggs. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of Boston to pay an Annuity to Mary F. Boggs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston is hereby au-
2 thorized to pay to Mary F. Boggs, widow of
3 Thomas F. Boggs, a former member of the fire
4 department, who died in consequence of injuries
5 received in the discharge of his duties as a mem-
6 ber of said department, an annuity not exceeding
7 one half the average compensation paid to him
8 each year during the last three years of his em-
9 ployment as a member of the fire department.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance by the city council of Boston, with
3 the approval of the mayor.
