RESOLVE

Providing for reimbursing the Towns of Ayer, Shirley and West Boylston for the Support of a Superintendent of Schools.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the commonwealth to the towns of Ayer,
3 Shirley and West Bolyston, the sum of two hundred
4 ninety-one dollars and sixty-seven cents, as reimburse-
5 ment for the payment of the salary of a superintendent
6 of schools, which said towns failed to receive because of
7 a technicality, although justly entitled thereto. The sum
8 named shall be apportioned to said towns on the basis
9 of the amounts paid by each on account of said salary
10 between July first and October first in the year nineteen
11 hundred and nine.
