## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen.

### AN ACT

To authorize the City of Boston to Pay a Sum of Money to Grant Gately and Olive P. Gately or their Legal Guardian.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston is hereby au-  
2 thorized to pay to Grant Gately and Olive P.  
3 Gately, or their legal guardian, at any time prior  
4 to the first day of January in the year nineteen  
5 hundred and eighteen, a sum of money not ex-  
6 ceeding the difference between the amount found  
7 due from the city of Boston to the said Mary M.  
8 Gately, as guardian of the said Grant Gately and  
9 Olive P. Gately, by an auditor whose report was  
10 filed in the superior court for the county of  
11 Suffolk in the month of March, nineteen hundred  
12 and eleven and the amount actually paid by said  
13 city, together with interest on said sum.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
