

SENATE No. 433

To accompany the petition of Frederick D. Lambert and others for legislation relative to the bridge over the Merrimac River in the town of Tyngsborough. Roads and Bridges.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Bridge over the Merrimac River in the Town of Tyngsborough.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The charge of the bridge over the
2 Merrimac river in the town of Tyngsborough is
3 hereby placed on the Massachusetts highway com-
4 mission.

1 SECTION 2. The said bridge shall be a state
2 highway, and the provisions of chapter forty-
3 seven of the Revised Laws and of all acts in addi-
4 tion thereto and in amendment thereof shall, so far
5 as they may be applicable, apply thereto in the
6 same manner and to the same extent as if the said
7 bridge were a land and not a waterway.

1 SECTION 3. The expense of keeping the bridge
2 in good repair for travel, and of operating the
3 draw in the bridge, and of maintaining the bridge
4 shall be paid by the commonwealth.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
