

SENATE No. 447

To accompany the petition of John E. Beck relative to the registering of the motor vehicle known as the autoped. Roads and Bridges.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen.

AN ACT

Relative to Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section one of chapter five hundred and
2 thirty-four of the acts of the year nineteen hun-
3 dred and nine, as amended by section one of
4 chapter two hundred and four of the acts of the
5 year nineteen hundred and fourteen, by section
6 one of chapter sixteen and also by chapter ninety-
7 nine of the general acts of the year nineteen
8 hundred and fifteen, is hereby further amended
9 by inserting after the word "astride", in the
10 third line of the eighth paragraph, the words: —
11 or a platform on which he stands, — so that said
12 paragraph will read as follows: — "Motor cycle"

13 shall apply only to motor vehicles having but
 14 two wheels in contact with the ground, and a
 15 saddle on which the driver sits astride, or a plat-
 16 form on which he stands, and to bicycles having
 17 a motor attached thereto and a driving wheel or
 18 wheels in contact with the ground in addition to
 19 the wheels of the bicycle itself.

 first day of April, 1916, as follows:

Section one of chapter five hundred and
 thirty-four of the acts of the year nineteen hun-
 dred and nine, as amended by section one of
 chapter two hundred and four of the acts of the
 year nineteen hundred and fourteen, by section
 one of chapter sixteen and also by chapter ninety-
 five of the general acts of the year nineteen
 hundred and fifteen is hereby further amended
 by inserting after the word "vehicle," in the
 third line of the eighth paragraph, the words:—
 "or a platform on which he stands"—so that said
 paragraph will read as follows:— "Motor vehicle,"
