AN ACT

Relative to the Cost of a Certain Sea Wall on Broad Canal in the City of Cambridge.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The estate of John J. Horgan is
2 hereby released from its obligation to repay to
3 the commonwealth one third part of the expense
4 incurred by the metropolitan park commission in
5 rebuilding a certain sea wall on Broad canal in the
6 city of Cambridge, under the provisions of chapter
7 seven hundred and forty-one of the acts of the
8 year nineteen hundred and thirteen.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
