AN ACT

Relative to a Way for Pedestrians in State Highways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 In all state highways hereafter constructed or recon-
2 structed, a way for pedestrians shall be built on or ap-
3 purtenant to the highway, of material like that of which
4 the roadway is constructed or of some other material
5 of similar hardness and durability.
