

Bill accompanying the recommendations of the State Forester
(House, No. 159). Agriculture. January 8.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventeen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Expenses of the Department of the State
Forester.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Section one of chapter four hundred and nine of the
2 acts of the year nineteen hundred and four, as amended
3 by section one of chapter four hundred and seventy-
4 three of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and seven
5 and by chapter two hundred and sixty-three of the acts
6 of the year nineteen hundred and nine, is hereby further
7 amended by adding at the end thereof the following:—
8 The state forester shall be furnished with an office in the
9 state house and may expend for the services of clerks,
10 stenographers and other office assistants, for traveling
11 expenses necessarily incurred in the discharge of his
12 duties, and for incidental office supplies and expenses in-
13 cluding the printing and binding of his annual report,
14 such sums as the general court shall annually appro-
15 priate.
