## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventeen.

---

### AN ACT

To provide for the Appointment of Additional Inspectors of Weights and Measures.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section two of chapter five hundred and  
2 thirty-four of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and  
3 seven, as amended by chapter four hundred and sixty-  
4 five of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and ten,  
5 by chapter six hundred and thirty-two of the acts of the  
6 year nineteen hundred and eleven, and by chapter two  
7 hundred and fifty-six of the acts of the year nineteen  
8 hundred and twelve, is hereby further amended by strik-  
9 ing out the words "six inspectors", in the first line, and  
10 inserting in place thereof the words:— eight inspectors,  
11 — so as to read as follows:— *Section 2.* The said com-

12 missioner may appoint eight inspectors. The annual  
13 salary of the commissioner shall be two thousand dollars.  
14 The annual salary of the inspectors shall be twelve hun-  
15 dred dollars each for the first year of service, thirteen  
16 hundred dollars for the second year, fourteen hundred  
17 dollars for the third year, and fifteen hundred dollars for  
18 the fourth year and for any subsequent year. They shall  
19 give bonds for the faithful performance of their duties.  
20 The commissioner shall be allowed for clerical services,  
21 travel and contingent office expenses for himself and his  
22 inspectors such sum as may be necessary, to be paid out  
23 of the treasury of the commonwealth.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
