

HOUSE No. 243

Bill accompanying the recommendations of the Metropolitan Park Commission (House, No. 220). Metropolitan Affairs. January 8.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventeen.

AN ACT

To enable the Metropolitan Park Commission to extend Mystic Valley Parkway to the Junction of Revere Beach and Middlesex Fells Parkways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan park commission is
2 hereby authorized to construct an extension of Mystic
3 Valley parkway, constructed to Mystic avenue, Medford,
4 under authority of chapter six hundred and ninety-nine
5 of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and twelve,
6 from said Mystic avenue over lands under the control of
7 said commission across Mystic river to a junction with
8 Middlesex Fells and Revere beach parkways in said
9 Medford, and for this purpose said commission may ex-
10 pend a sum not exceeding three hundred and fifty thou-
11 sand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. To meet expenditures made under author-
2 ity of this act, the treasurer and receiver general, with the
3 approval of the governor and council, shall issue bonds
4 or certificates of indebtedness to the amount of three
5 hundred and fifty thousand dollars as an addition to the
6 Metropolitan Parks Loan, Series Two. Such bonds or
7 scrip shall be issued in such amounts and upon such
8 terms, and shall bear such rate of interest not exceeding
9 four per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, and shall
10 be paid serially in such amounts and at such times within
11 a period not exceeding forty years as shall be determined
12 by the treasurer and receiver general, with the approval
13 of the governor and council, to be for the best interests
14 of the commonwealth.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
