### RESOLUTIONS

In favor of a National Law regulating the Employment  
of Labor.

1 *Whereas*, The diversity of the labor laws in the several  
2 states causes unfair and unequal competition and results  
3 in much confusion and injustice; therefore be it

4 *Resolved*, That the general court of Massachusetts  
5 hereby expresses its belief that the congress of the United  
6 States should take the necessary steps in order to pro-  
7 vide for a national law regulating the employment of  
8 labor throughout the whole country.

9 *Resolved*, That copies of these resolutions be sent by  
10 the secretary of the commonwealth to the president of  
11 the United States, the presiding officers of both branches  
12 of congress and to the senators and representatives in  
13 congress from this commonwealth.
