

HOUSE No. 511

Bill accompanying the petition of Isaac U. Wood that a part of the money received from the licensing of motor vehicles be paid to cities and towns. Roads and Bridges. January 10.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventeen.

AN ACT

To provide for Payment to the Cities and Towns Concerned of Thirty-five Per Cent of the Sums received by the Commonwealth for Licenses for Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Thirty-five per cent of the sums received
2 by the commonwealth for licenses for motor vehicles shall
3 be paid into the treasuries of the cities and towns in
4 which the owners of the licensed vehicles reside, or in
5 which the same are chiefly used if the city or town in
6 which the owner resides is not the place in which the
7 vehicle is chiefly used.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
