## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventeen.

### AN ACT

To place the Janitors of Six-or-more-Room School Houses in Methuen under the Civil Service Laws.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The janitors of all school houses in  
2 Methuen in which are located six or more class-rooms are  
3 hereby placed under the civil service laws, rules and  
4 regulations of the commonwealth, and their terms of  
5 office shall be permanent, except that they may be re-  
6 moved in accordance with such civil service laws, rules  
7 and regulations; the persons now holding such positions  
8 as janitors in such buildings shall continue therein with-  
9 out passing the civil service examinations.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
