Bill accompanying the petition of George A. Whitney and others relative to approval of payment of additional compensation to state employees. Public Service. January 11.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventeen.

AN ACT

To regulate the Approval of Payment of Additional Compensation in the Service of the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. All compensation in whatsoever manner
2 computed, whether by the day, week, month or year, or
3 by any other method of calculation, regularly paid as
4 fixed salary, remuneration or recompense to officials and
5 employees in any and all departments of the common-
6 wealth, whether executive, judicial or otherwise, shall be
7 payment in full for all services performed for the com-
8 monwealth: *provided*, that additional compensation may
9 be allowed for special or extraordinary services only when
10 such services are performed outside of statutory or the
11 regularly fixed office hours and are deemed necessary by

12 the head of the department, board or commission, and
13 the nature of and necessity for such services are specified
14 in a statement to the supervisor of administration.

1 SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 herewith are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
