RESOLVE

Providing for the Establishment of Trout Rearing Stations
in the Counties of Franklin and Hampshire.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the commonwealth the sum of five thousand
3 dollars, to be spent under the direction of the board of
4 commissioners on fisheries and game in the construction
5 and maintenance of stations for the rearing of trout in
6 the counties of Franklin and Hampshire.
