## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

### AN ACT

To authorize the City of Haverhill to erect a Police Station Building with Accommodations for the Courts of Essex County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of purchasing land and  
2 constructing thereon a police station building, which shall  
3 contain accommodations for the police department of the  
4 city of Haverhill and for the courts of Essex county, the  
5 said city of Haverhill may incur indebtedness to an  
6 amount not exceeding one hundred and fifty thousand  
7 dollars and may from time to time issue bonds, notes  
8 or scrip therefor, payable at periods not exceeding forty  
9 years from their respective dates of issue and bearing  
10 interest at a rate not exceeding four per cent per annum.

1 SECTION 2. The city of Haverhill may lease to the  
 2 county of Essex a part of said building for the use of the  
 3 courts of said county upon such terms as may be agreed  
 4 upon between the said city and county.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
