

HOUSE No. 860

Bill accompanying the petition of Henry I. Harriman relative to the completion of the improvements on the northerly bank of the Charles river and the construction of a boulevard, parkway or driveway from Arsenal street in the town of Watertown to Gerry's landing and Mt. Auburn street in the city of Cambridge. Metropolitan Affairs. January 15.

AN ACT

To provide for Completing the Improvements on the Northerly Bank of the Charles River and the Construction of a Parkway Connection from Arsenal Street in the Town of Watertown over the Charles River Reservation to Gerry's Landing and Mt. Auburn Street in the City of Cambridge.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The Metropolitan park commission is
2 hereby authorized to acquire land for and to construct
3 a parkway or boulevard from Arsenal street in the town
4 of Watertown easterly over Charles river reservation
5 along the northerly bank of the Charles river, to Gerry's
6 Landing and Mount Auburn street in the city of Cam-

7 bridge, and to expend therefor a sum not exceeding
8 ninety thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. To meet expenditures made under au-
2 thority of this act the treasurer and receiver general,
3 with the approval of the governor and council, shall issue
4 scrip or certificates of indebtedness bearing interest at a
5 rate not exceeding four per cent per annum to the amount
6 of ninety thousand dollars, as an addition to the Metro-
7 politan Parks Loan, Series Two. The treasurer and
8 receiver general shall add to the existing sinking fund to
9 provide for the payment of the said securities, and they
10 shall be issued, and additions to said sinking fund shall
11 be assessed and collected in accordance with the provi-
12 sions of chapter two hundred and eighty-eight of the
13 acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-four and
14 in accordance with the provisions of chapter two hun-
15 dred and eighty-three of the acts of the year eighteen
16 hundred and ninety-five and of chapter four hundred and
17 nineteen of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and
18 ninety-nine and of acts in amendment thereof and in
19 addition thereto.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
