

HOUSE No. 1025

Bill accompanying the petition of Leon E. Thompson relative to appropriations for school purposes in the city of Lynn. Municipal Finance. January 16.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventeen.

AN ACT

Relative to Appropriations for School Purposes in the City of
Lynn.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The amount which may be received by
2 the city of Lynn from the commonwealth in the year
3 nineteen hundred and seventeen under the provisions of
4 section twenty-three of chapter two hundred and sixty-
5 nine of the General Acts of the year nineteen hundred
6 and sixteen shall be available for school committee ex-
7 penditures and appropriations to the same extent as if
8 the same were raised by local taxation, under the pro-
9 visions of chapter one hundred and seventy-eight of the
10 acts of the year nineteen hundred and nine, as amended
11 by chapter two hundred and ninety of the Special Acts
12 of the year nineteen hundred and sixteen.

1 SECTION 2. The words "valuation of the taxable
2 property in said city", as used in chapter one hundred
3 and seventy-eight of the acts of the year nineteen hundred
4 and nine, as amended by chapter two hundred and
5 ninety of the Special Acts of the year nineteen hundred
6 and sixteen, shall, for the purpose of determining school
7 committee appropriations and expenditures for the year
8 nineteen hundred and eighteen be construed to mean the
9 valuation of the total taxable property in said city for the
10 year nineteen hundred and sixteen, unaffected by the pro-
11 visions of chapter two hundred and sixty-nine of the
12 General Acts of the year nineteen hundred and sixteen,
13 plus the average increase in valuation of said city for the
14 years nineteen hundred and fourteen, nineteen hundred
15 and fifteen and nineteen hundred and sixteen over the
16 preceding year, in each case.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
